Harm Reduction

If you are a person who uses drugs and substances, or is seeking support for a friend or family member, This program offers Naloxone kits & overdose prevention training, information about safer drug use, monthly HIV, Hep C and other testing drives, support and referrals to health and social services, and peer learning & social groups

Rainbow Space

If you are a person who identifies as a member of the 2SLGBTQ+ community in York Region or are seeking support for a friend or family member as an ally. This program offers Inclusive and safer spaces to gather together and build social networks, opportunities to organize and participate in recreational activities, information and resources about health and social services, sexual Health education, and supplies and resources.

HIV and AIDS

CAYR provides a safe, inclusive, social space for individuals to engage with others. HIV case management assists with transit support to medical appointments, connections to food banks, and joining support groups.

HCV Programs

We have a peer advisory committee that is peer-led and facilitated by members of the community. For those that may be living with or at risk of HCV, we offer support and referrals for doctors and treatment that may be needed. HCV Program will offer workshops and information session throughout the year to help build awareness and information around HCV. We offer weekly outreach to different agencies and organizations.
